The Restricted Stock Units shall vest as follows: 33.33% of the RSUs vested on January 15, 2021 and an additional 33.33% of the RSUs will each vest on January 15, 2022 and January 15, 2023.
13. Vesting is dependent upon continuous active service as an employee, consultant or director of the Company or a subsidiary of the Company (Service) throughout the vesting period. The Restricted Stock Units shall vest as follows: 33.33% of the RSUs vested on January 15, 2022 and an additional 33.33% of the RSUs will each vest on January 15, 2023 and January 15, 2024.
